Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner's pay has not been fixed in the post of Assistant Professor Stage III. He was to be promoted to the post of Associate Professor Stage IV and his arrears of basic balance salary was to be paid or released at an early date. In this regard, the petitioner made a representation before the concerned authorities including the DPI on 23.10.2024. This representation has not been responded to as yet.

Heard the learned counsels for the University, the

College Service Commission, the College Authorities and the respondent nos. 4, 6 & 7.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that if a representation is pending before the DPI, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

In view of the fact that a representation dated 23.10.2024 is pending before the concerned DPI, let the said respondent no.2 consider the representation in accordance with law and as expeditiously as possible, preferably within eight weeks from the date of communication of this order.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

The merits of the case have not been given into.
