Learned advocate appearing for the respondent nos. 6 and 9 submits that the amount of Rs. 60,01,000/- has already been deposited with the learned Registrar General, High Court at Calcutta on February 9, 2026. The photocopy of the receipt dated February 9, 2026 is taken on record. A copy of such receipt has already been handed over to Mr. Chatterjee, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner.

Mr. Chatterjee, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the society as well as the Cooperation Directorate is unable to hand over possession of the property, which the petitioner has

purchased by way of auction sale till date. He submits that since the authorities have failed and neglected to deliver the property to the petitioner in spite of the fact that the petitioner complied with all formalities, the petitioner is not interested to get the property for the present and prays that the amount which the petitioner deposited with the cooperative credit society, may be paid to the petitioner.

After some argument learned advocate appearing for the respondent nos. 6 and 9 seeks an accommodation to take further instructions from his client.

On the prayer of the learned advocate appearing for the respondent nos. 6 and 9, list this matter on March 17, 2026 under the same heading.
