1. An adjournment has been sought for on the ground of illness of the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner.
2. Learned Additional Advocate General submits that cause of the writ petition does not survive any more since the Legal Enforcing Agency has already taken cognizance in respect of the grievances made in the writ petition.
3. Learned Additional Advocate General draws the attention of this Court to two reports one filed by the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, Siliguri dated 17.1.2026 and the other by the Additional Regional Transport Officer, Siliguri dated 12.2.2026 to demonstrate that the action has already been taken by intercepting 43 number of buses by imposing penalties to the tune of Rs. 22,01089/- and such activities are still continuing.
4. It is submitted that since the cognizance has already been taken, at present as such nothing remains to be adjudicated.

5. Since the learned advocate for the petitioner remains unrepresented, let this matter appear on 2nd April, 2026 under the heading 'For Orders' to apprise this Court as to whether the cause made in the writ petition still survives or not.
