- 1) Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioners is taken on record.
- 2) It appears that all the four writ petitioners were found not eligible to be appointed for the post of Constable (GD) in Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) but reasons for negating candidature of the petitioners are different. Therefore petitioners ought not to have joined in one writ petition espousing different causes of action.
- 3) Hence, writ petition stands dismissed in respect of petitioner nos. 2, 3 and 4 and the present writ petition shall be entertained in respect of the petitioner no. 1 (hereinafter referred to as "petitioner").
- 4) However, this order shall not preclude the petitioner nos. 2 to 4 to take steps in accordance with law on the selfsame cause of action if they are aggrieved by the decision of the respondent authorities.
- 5) The petitioner was found unfit in review medical examination held on 24th November, 2025 on the ground delineating therein.

- 6) The concerned respondent authority is directed to file a report in the form of affidavit disclosing as to why the petitioner was found unfit in review medical examination.
- 7) Let such report be filed by three weeks from date.
- 8) List the matter under the same heading for further consideration on 3rd February, 2026.
