The extension of the interim order granted earlier
on December 26, 2022 is prayed for.

Since there is no reason made out for deviating
from the interim order passed initially, the said interim
order is extended till February 28, 2023 or until
further orders, whichever is earlier.

C.A.N. 1 of 2023 is disposed of accordingly.

The writ petition shall next be listed before the
regular Bench having determination in the monthly list
of cases for the month of February, 2023 or as per
convenience of the said Bench.

Liberty is given to the parties to mention the matter before the regular Bench for inclusion in the list.

In the event the matter cannot be taken up for reasons beyond control before the expiry of the extended time-frame of the interim order, liberty is given to the petitioner to pray for further extension on the basis of the interim prayers made in the writ petition itself.
