1. Affidavit-of-service filed be kept with the record.
2. The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 303 of 2024, presently pending before the Learned Additional District Judge, 2nd Court Suri, Birbhum to any learned Additional District Judge Durgapur under the District Judge Paschim Burdwan.
3. None appears for the opposite party.
4. On hearing the learned counsels for the parties and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the Matrimonial Suit has been filed in the Suri Court, by the husband/opposite party herein.
5. The petitioner/wife herein resides at Chora, P.S.- Andal, District- Paschim Bardhaman, PIN 713321.
6. Considering the said difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Suri Court, on regular basis, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of***

2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12),

directs that Matrimonial Suit No. 303 of 2024 be withdrawn from the Court of learned Additional District Judge, 2nd Court Suri, Birbhum and be transferred to any learned Additional District Judge Durgapur under the District Judge Paschim Burdwan.

7. Learned Additional District Judge, Paschim Burdwan shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.

8. Keeping in mind the case of the opposite party herein, the learned Additional District Judge shall be at liberty to permit the opposite party to **appear virtually**, if such prayer is made.

9. CO 4413 of 2025 is disposed of.
