1. This revisional application has been filed with a prayer for quashing the proceeding in connection with BGR No. 351 of 2019 arising out of Nodakhali Police Station Case no. 26 of 2019 pending before the Learned Judicial Magistrate, 4th Court, Alipore.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that it is a case of omnibus allegation against the petitioners. The case was investigated and chargesheet was filed under Sections 498A/ 406/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
