The petitioner is aggrieved by the judgment and order dated September 12, 2022, passed by the learned Waqf Tribunal, West Bengal, in Suit No. 20 of 2013. The learned tribunal had dismissed the suit, inter alia, holding that the suit property was a wakf property, although there was no deed of wakf. An unregistered document allegedly creating the wakf was also not traceable.

The matter requires hearing. In the meantime, the parties shall maintain status quo with regard to the nature, character and possession of the property in question upto July 31, 2024, or until further orders whichever is earlier.
