This is an application wherein petitioners have prayed for quashing of the entire proceeding being Shakespeare Sarani P.S. Case No.02 of 2025 dated 05.01.2025 corresponding to G.R.(S) 18 of 2025.

The allegation is that one Kishan Kumar Verma sold vehicles on behalf of the petitioner without her knowledge to different parties by taking money in that account and thereafter transferred that money in his account.

Petitioners further case is due to such act and omission outstanding loan amount cases are pending in the name of petitioner, though he never took such loan. Further allegation is that Kishan Kumar Verma forged all the documents that are required for the registration of vehicles and has transferred the vehicles in the name of the petitioner who is a relative of Kishan Kumar Verma.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and he pointed out that there are agreement that he will sell four vehicles to him and he has made all the payments. The present case is essentially a business dispute arising out of vehicle purchase and sale transactions and the

complainant is attempting to convert the civil dispute into a criminal case. He further submits that the anticipatory bail prayer of petitioner no.1 has already been rejected by the City Sessions Court. Investigating Agency has added the name of petitioner no.2 and thereby managed to get the warrant of arrest which is issued against him.

Having heard learned Counsel for the petitioners, the application is admitted.

Petitioners are directed to serve a copy of application upon the State through the office of Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon opposite party no.2 through speed post intimating next date of hearing and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.

Let the matter be listed under the heading "Contested Application" in the Monthly List of April, 2026.
