1. Report filed by the District Inspector of Schools (SE), South 24 Parganas signed on August 7, 2026 in Court today be kept with the records.

2. The report reveals that the petitioner's father was an Assistant Teacher who passed away on September 4, 1972. The name of the petitioner's father is mentioned in the acquaintance roll of the school on and from October 1965 to December 1968. The school authority has informed that the name of the petitioner's father is not found in any other school records.

3. The DI has opined that the Assistant Teacher may have resigned or retired in December 1968. No document for availing pension preferred by the petitioner's father till his death on September 4, 1972 is available. There was no claim from the petitioner's mother for availing pension till her death in 2005.

4. For considering the petitioner's prayer for grant of family pension for being the unmarried daughter of

the deceased teacher, the DI requires all service related documents pertaining to the service of the petitioner's father. In the absence of all documents, it will not be possible for the DI to process the family pension file of the petitioner.

5. Learned advocate representing the petitioner seeks time to revert with instruction with regard to the documents available with the petitioner for processing the family pension file.

6. On such prayer, re-list the matter on August 26, 2026.

7. Learned advocate for the petitioner shall produce the documents as mentioned in page 29 of the writ petition on the adjourned date.

8. Let notice be served upon the school authority.

9. Parties to act on the basis of the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official *website* of this Court.
