1. The present revisional application is filed praying for quashing of the proceedings being Spl. Court Cases No. 61 of 2025 pending before the Court of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge at Chinsurah, Hooghly corresponding to Mogra Police Station Case No. 538 of 2025 dated 10th November, 2025 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/351(2)/79 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and 3(1)(r)(s) of SC-ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

2. It appears *prima facie* that there was initially a business transaction between the parties and subsequently the present case has been registered.

3. The instant revisional application is required to be heard.

4. The petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the instant revisional application upon the opposite party no.1 through

6. Pending hearing of the instant revisional application, the proceedings being Spl. Court Cases No. 61 of 2025 pending before the Court of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge at Chinsurah, Hooghly corresponding to Mogra Police Station Case No. 538 of 2025 dated 10th November, 2025 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/351(2)/79 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and 3(1)(r)(s) of SC-ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 be stayed till 27th February, 2026 or until further orders whichever is earlier.

7. Liberty to pray for extension, modification, variation and/or vacating of the order upon notice to the other side.
