1. Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. By the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks direction upon the respondent authorities particularly respondent No.2, the Commissioner of School Education, Government of West Bengal to approve the petitioner in 'A' category scale from the date of her joining.
3. The petitioner contends that she joined as Dearoa FP School, P.O.-Mangalganj, District-North 24-Parganas on 1st December, 2021 with B.Ed qualification. The petitioner has not yet completed six months bridge course. The petitioner claims for 'A'

category scale of pay. However, the same is still pending consideration. Hence, this writ petition.

4. Mr. Somesh Kumar Ghosh, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled to 'A' category scale of pay.
5. Mr. Pritam Chowdhury, learned Advocate appearing for the State submits that the petitioner has not yet made any representation before the appropriate authority for due consideration.
6. In view of the above, liberty is granted to the petitioner to make appropriate application before the respondent No.2, Commissioner of School Education, Government of West Bengal within a period of four weeks. Upon receipt of such representation, the respondent No.2, Commissioner of School Education, Government of West Bengal shall consider the application of the petitioner and dispose of the same by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law upon notice to the petitioner within a period of 12 weeks.
7. Learned advocate for the petitioner is directed to communicate this order to the respondent No.2, the Commissioner of School Education, Government of West Bengal, for necessary compliance.
8. With the above direction, the writ petition being **WPA 29718 of 2025** stands disposed of.

9. Since no affidavits have been called for, the allegation made in the writ petition is deemed to be not admitted.
10. Interim order, if any, stands vacated.
11. All connected applications, if any, stand disposed of.
12. There shall be no order as to costs.
13. All concerned parties shall act in terms of the copy of the order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
14. Urgent Photostat certified copy of the order, if applied for, be given to the parties on compliance of all necessary legal formalities.
