Re: CAN 4 of 2025 (Restoration)

2. An application for restoration has been filed on 27.07.2025. The appeal stood dismissed for default on 11.04.2025. The stand taken in the restoration application is that the appeal, remained pending for nearly eight years, thereafter it came up for consideration on 11.04.2025, when the list could not be marked by the office of the learned advocate for the appellants.
