In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with AJC Bose B Garden Police Station case no. 172 of 2025 dated 29.08.2025 under Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 209 days, charge-sheet has already been submitted and there are no materials to support the charges so far as the prosecution evidence is concerned.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the Case Diary. The Statement under Section 183 of BNSS was denied by the victim before the learned Magistrate. The medico legal report was also refused, however, there are materials to support that the victim was pregnant. The victim is aged about 15 years.

Learned advocate for the de-facto complainant is present and submits that a relationship is still existing.

Be that as it may, having regard to the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, petitioner namely, **Akash Das** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special (POCSO) Court, Howrah.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Howrah without the prior permission of the learned Court.

Thus, the application for bail being CRM (M) No. 17 of 2026 is **allowed**.
