This Court by the order dated July 24, 2024 had directed issuance of notice upon the opposite parties and had directed listing of the matter for final disposal.

Mr. Das, learned advocate for the petitioners files copy of the letters and e-mail evidencing service of such notice upon the opposite parties as well as upon their learned advocate in the Court below but none appears on behalf of the opposite parties.

For ends of justice, a further chance is given to the opposite parties to contest the matter.

The petitioners are required to issue notice communicating this order to the opposite parties and to their learned advocate in the Court below and to file a further affidavit-of-service on the next date of hearing.

Let the revisional application be included in the **Combined Monthly List of December 2024** under the same heading.

The interim order, under these circumstances, needs to be extended. The interim order passed on January 05, 2024, which was subsisting till June 30, 2024, is reinforced and is extended **till the end of the month of December 2024**, or until further order(s), whichever is earlier.
