1. This matter has come up under the heading “*For extension of interim order*”.
2. Mr. Das learned advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners by placing before this Court a copy of the print out of the screenshot of an email communication dated 20th February 2025, would submit that due intimation of the pendency of the instant revisional application before this Court has been given to the learned advocate representing the opposite parties on his email id. Let a copy of the screenshot be retained with the record.
3. Despite notice, the opposite parties are not represented. It, however, appears that an application for vacating of the interim order passed by this Court and for allowing the petitioner to complete the remaining building being CAN 1 of 2025 has been filed.
