This revisional application has been filed assailing the order dated 13th November, 2024 passed in connection with GR Case No.1645 of 2014 wherein the learned Judicial Magistrate, 18th Court, Calcutta framed charge against the accused/petitioner herein under Sections 354A/506/509 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Mr. Sabyasachi Banerjee, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted by referring several documents, including the judgment passed in CRR 1946 of 2015, that there is hardly any scope to go beyond the provision of Sections 506 and 509 of the Indian Penal Code and prays for setting aside the order.

3. Having heard the learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as having gone through the

documents annexed with this revisional application, the same stands admitted.

4. Petitioner is directed to serve notice along with a copy of the revisional application upon the State through the office of the learned Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta, and file an affidavit-of-service on the returnable date.

5. Service regarding opposite party no.2 stands dispensed with as Mr. Satadru Lahiri, learned counsel, is appearing on behalf of the opposite party no.2.

6. Let the matter appear in the list under the heading "Contested Application" on 10th June, 2025 at 2.00 p.m.

7. Liberty to mention with regard to the prayer for stay in case the matter is not heard on the returnable date.
