1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Petitioner participated in the selection process for being appointed as Constable (GD) under Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs).
3. Petitioner qualified in written test and Physical Standard test but in Detailed Medical Examination and Review Medical Examination petitioner was declared unfit as multiple hesitation cut marks were found on left forearm.
4. It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that other medical tests were conducted at the instance of the concerned respondent authorities but Psychometry including IQ test was not performed.
5. Petitioner on attending Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata on 22nd December, 2025 had undergone Psychometry and IQ test and the report dated 23rd December, 2025 which is at page 30 discloses

there was no significant Psychopathology with a remark that petitioner had average intellectual functioning (IQ=108).

6. Union of India is represented by learned advocates.
7. Learned advocate representing Union of India has prayed for accommodation to obtain instruction.
8. Concerned respondent authority is directed to file a report in the form of affidavit disclosing as to why petitioner was declared unfit based on Revised Medical Guidelines of May, 2015.
9. Let such report be filed by three weeks from date.
10. List the matter under the same heading for further consideration on 24th February, 2026.
