1. Parties are represented through their respective learned advocates.
2. Heard learned advocates for the parties.
3. Mr. Mazumdar, learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance of the petitioners is that the petitioners are falsely implicated in several cases and in some case they have obtained some protection order. It is further submitted that even the petitioners are in the dark as to how many cases they have been implicated.
4. Mr. Nandy, learned Spl. Additional Public Prosecutor for the State-Respondent No.1 submits that the similar prayer has been made in a criminal revisional application in the interlocutory stage, against which the learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that this criminal revisional application is with regard to different case against one particular FIR. The subject-

matter of the writ petition is quite different although an interlocutory application may be made in a particular case.

5. However, considering that there is issue of fundamental right, sufficient opportunity should be granted to writ petitioners to pursue their case and necessary opportunity should be granted to withdraw the earlier interlocutory application. Thus, their writ application should be heard out.
6. In the meantime, learned advocate for the State shall obtain instruction as to the number of cases in which the writ petitioners are wanted.
7. The matter be listed before the Regular Bench one week after vacation.
10. If certain cases are instituted till date, no coercive steps be taken till 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2026.
11. Urgent Photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be given to the parties, on priority basis, upon compliance of all necessary formalities.
