1. Affidavits of service filed in Court today be kept with the records.
2. The petitioner is aggrieved by the communication dated December 10, 2024 disclosing that the petitioner's prayer for employment cannot be processed for the reasons mentioned therein.
3. The legality and validity of the reasons for disallowing the petitioner's prayer has to be decided upon exchange of affidavits.
4. Let a report by way of affidavit disclosing all facts and figures by the Eastern Coalfields Limited be prepared and circulated within a period of eight weeks. Exception thereto, if any, be filed within a fortnight thereafter.
5. Liberty to mention the matter for inclusion after completion of the aforesaid time period.
6. As the writ petition has been taken up for consideration by the Court, no further order is

required to be passed in the connected application filed by the petitioner. The same stands disposed of.
