The application being CAN 2 of 2026 under
Section 5 of the Limitation Act is taken up for
consideration. Although it is stated in the
application for condonation of delay that there
is delay of 42 days but as per report of the
department the delay is 10 days.

Although there is an objection by the
learned advocate for the claimant/respondent
no.1. with regard to the condonation of delay
but considering the period of delay and the
ground shown, this Court is of the view that in
the interest of justice, the delay should be
condoned. Thus, the delay in filing this appeal
is condoned. Accordingly **CAN 2 of 2026**

stands disposed of.
