1. Learned Advocate for the parties are present.
2. As it is submitted by the learned Advocate for the appellant that the statutory amount of Rs.25,000/- is already deposited and the copy of the receipt is filed, the direction dated 20th March, 2026, direction the appellant to deposit the statutory amount of Rs.25,000/- stands modified and recalled.
3. The appeal is admitted.
4. CAN 2 of 2026 which is an application for stay taken up for consideration.
5. Heard the learned Advocates. The appellant insurance company has deposited the statutory amount of Rs.25,000/-, thus there shall be an interim order of stay of the judgment and award 30th August, 2025 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, 3rd Court, Cooch Behar,

in MAC Case No.16 of 2018 for a period of five weeks.

6. The appellant insurance company shall deposit the entire awarded sum along with interest as directed by the learned Trial Court within five weeks.

7. In the event, the entire awarded sum is deposited within five weeks the ad interim order of stay shall continue till disposal of this application.

8. The Trial Court record be called for at the special messenger cost to be deposited in by the appellant within two weeks and the informal paper books be prepared upon arrival of the Trial Court record.

9. Let the matter be mentioned before the next available circuit.

10. Accordingly CAN 2 of 2026 stands disposed of.

11. Urgent certified copy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties subject to compliance with all requisite formalities.
