Apprehending arrest in connection with Dinhata P.S Case
No. 59 of 2026, dated 10.02.2026 for alleged offence punishable
under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/351(2)/3(5) of the
Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023, the present application has been
preferred.

Earlier anticipatory bail was rejected by the learned Sessions
Judge, Cooch Behar.

Perused the Case Diary. Considering the statement of
witnesses, nature of injury I am inclined to allow anticipatory
bail.

Accordingly, it is directed direct that in the event of arrest
the petitioners, namely, **Mithu Hoque @ Mithu Haque, Kayum
Haque @ Kaiyum Hoque, Hachen Ali @ Hachher Ali, Hachem**

Ali, Ashadul Haque @ Asadul Hoque, Kulachum Bibi @ Kalchum Bibi, Rashida Bibi & Fatema Bibi, shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be a local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dinhata and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, with a further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the learned Trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall meet the Investigating Officer of this case once in a week or until further.

In the event the petitioners fails to comply with the aforesaid directions, without any justifiable cause, the learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel their bail without any further reference to this Court.

The application for anticipatory bail, being **CRM (A) 219 of 2026**, is, thus, **disposed of**.
