The present application under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been preferred by the petitioners in connection with Sitai, P.S. Case No. 16 of 2026 dated 30.01.2026 under Sections 126(2)/118(2)/109/3(5) of BNSS, 2023;

On careful perusal of Case Diary it appears that strong incriminating elements against the present Petitioner No. 2, namely, Ajidul Miah @ Miya. However, considering the extent of involvement of Petitioner No. 2, namely, Arjiya Bibi @ Ejiya Bibi @ Arjina Bibi @ Rajiya Bibi and her period of detention since 30th January, 2026, I am inclined to allow bail to Petitioner No. 2.

Accordingly, Petitioner No. 2, namely, **Arjiya Bibi @ Ejiya Bibi @ Arjina Bibi @ Rajiya Bibi**, shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be a local, to the satisfaction of the learned learned Additional Sessions Judge, Dinahata with a further condition that she will not leave the jurisdiction of the Sitai Police Station without prior permission of the I.O. till investigation is going on.

The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence and shall not influence the witnesses in any manner whatsoever and she shall attend the learned Trial Court on all the dates, as specified for hearing. In the event the petitioner fails to comply with the aforesaid directions, without any justifiable cause, the learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel her bail, without any further reference to this Court.

The application for bail, being **CRM (M) 97 of 2026**, is **disposed of**.
