This is an application for modification of the order of bail passed by this Court on December 8, 2022. This Court by order 8.12.2022 was pleased to grant bail to the appellant on furnishing two local sureties namely, Sujit Das and Debananda Roy of Rs. 20,000/- each along with other conditions.

Pursuant to the order passed by this Court necessary application was made before the learned Court below and the Learned ACJM, Mekhliganj, Cooch Behar for compliance. Learned ACJM, Mekhliganj did not accept the surety bonds of the said sureties and declared them unfit under the provisions of Section

441 of the Code of Criminal Procedure vide its order dated 14.12.2022.

Pursuant to the order passed by the Learned ACJM Mekhliganj, Cooch Behar, the petitioners have come up with this instant application.

It is the contention of the appellant that Md. Rafikul and Nur Alam who are acquainted with the appellant and are residents of Mekhliganj, be made as sureties.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor of the Circuit Bench at Jaipalguri submits in the event the persons named are the residents of Mekhliganj, Cooch Behar they may be furnished as local sureties subject to satisfaction of the CJM, Cooch Behar.

Upon hearing of the learned advocates for the parties, this application stands disposed of. Order dated 8.12.2022 passed by this Court is modified to the extent that Md. Rafikul and Nur Alam may stand as sureties for the appellants subject to the satisfaction of CJM, Cooch Behar. Other conditions remain unaltered.
