Learned advocates for the State are present.

CRAN 2 of 2022 filed by the appellant, Sheikh Sohel Rana is moved, praying for his bail till disposal of the appeal.

It is submitted by learned advocates for the appellant that on pleading guilty of the offence under Section 14A of the Foreigners Act, the accused/ appellant was convicted under Section 14A of Foreigners Act and was sentenced to suffer imprisonment for two years along with a fine of Rs.14,000/-.

Learned advocates for the State opposed the prayer for bail drawing my attention to the provision under Section 375 of the Cr.P.C. It is contended that the petitioner is a Foreigner and the appeal can be heard only on the point of legality of the sentence.

At this stage, learned advocate for appellant submit that CRAN 2 of 2022 may be taken up together with the appeal otherwise he will be prejudiced.
