In re : CRAN 1 of 2026

1. CRAN 1 of 2026 is moved by the petitioner praying for condonation of delay of 15 days in preferring the appeal.
2. The delay shown in the averments made in the application is sufficient.
3. Considering the grounds as made out and in the interest of justice, the delay is condoned and the application being CRAN 1 of 2026 stands disposed of.
4. CRAN 1 of 2026 is disposed of.

5. Vide the impugned order, the learned trial Court was pleased to cancel the bail of the petitioner herein and issue warrant of

arrest on the ground that the petitioner allegedly failed to comply with the condition of meeting the investigating officer.

6. It is the contention of the petitioner that he made an attempt to meet the investigating officer but the investigating officer refused to record his attendance.
7. Accordingly, considering the nature of offence, the State being the relevant party in this present case, petitioner is directed to serve upon the State who shall place a report as to the issue raised by the petitioner in the revisional application before this Court on 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2026.
8. State shall also ensure that the investigating officer is present in the present case.
9. Pending hearing, the impugned order dated 06.02.2026 being PTN No. 3271 of 2025, arising out of Matigara P.S. Case No. 383 of 2025 under Sections 316(2)/318(4)/61(2) of Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita, 2023, pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siliguri, be stayed till the 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 or until further orders whichever is earlier.
10. Matter be listed on **15<sup>th</sup> June, 2026**.
