1. Since questions of fact as well as law are involved, the appeal is admitted and will be heard on the grounds taken in the memorandum of appeal.

2. The appellant shall put in postal costs and requisites for service of notice of the appeal on the respondents within a fortnight from date.

3. The appellant is given liberty to collect all the records from the Arbitrator, who shall cooperate in the matter, for the purpose of preparing the requisite number of informal paper books.

4. The appellant, upon collecting such records, shall keep the same in its safe custody and file the same at the time of hearing of the appeal.

5. Informal paper books, as directed above, shall be prepared and filed within eight weeks from date.

6. Liberty to mention the appeal for enlistment as and when the same is ready for hearing.
