1. The revisional application has been preferred praying for quashing of proceeding in Dinhata Police Station Case Nos. 336 of 2026 dated 18.05.2026 under Sections 420/406/409 of the Indian Penal Code pending before Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Dinhata.

2. On hearing the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears from the written complaint and the formal F. I. R. that the incident alleged in the present case occurred on 17.06.2016 and it is after almost 10 long years that the written complaint has been filed wherein an allegation of demanding Rs. 43,000/- has been made, though admittedly a receipt was issued. The

petitioner's case for such demand has been explained in para 4 of the revisional application.

3. Considering the said facts, this Court finds that the petitioner has made out a prima facie case for hearing and as such the petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite parties and file affidavit of service on the next date.

4. Pending hearing of the revisional application, the proceeding in Dinhata Police Station Case Nos. 336 of 2026 dated 18.05.2026, under Sections 420/406/409 of the Indian Penal Code pending before the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Dinhata be stayed till 26th of August, 2026 or until further order, whichever is earlier.

5. Leave to file supplementary affidavit, as prayed, be granted.

6. Matter to appear before the available next Circuit Bench and the petitioner to file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
