1. The present criminal revision has been preferred praying for quashing of the proceedings of GR Case No.375 of 2026 arising out of Alipurduar women Police Station Case No.14 of 2026 dated 23.02.2026 under Sections 85/115(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and read with Sections 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 pending before the Court of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipurduar.
2. On perusal of the nature of allegation as made in the written complaint, it appears that on 01.12.2021, the Complainant was, she was married to Accused No.1 as per Hindu Customs and

Rituals, with all demands fulfilled. After about 3 months of marriage, she was subjected to mental and physical cruelty on the demand of bringing more money by her husband and in-laws. On 16.02.2026 the Complainant's husband came to her paternal house and handed her a divorce paper, then verbally abused her and also subjected her to physical cruelty.

3. The present petitioners are sisters-in-law and the sister-in-law's husband of the de facto complaint.
4. Considering the said materials in record, the petitioners have a prima facie case of hearing and accordingly directed to serve upon the opposite parties and file affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
5. The pending hearing of the proceedings in GR Case No.375 of 2026 arising out of Alipurduar women Police Station Case No.14 of 2026 dated 23.02.2026 under Sections 85/115(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and read with Sections 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, pending before the Court of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipurduar.
6. In respect of the present accused person stayed till 28.08.2026 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
7. Matter be listed before the next circuit bench.
