1. The revisional application has been preferred praying for quashing of the proceedings pertaining to Siliguri P.S. Case No. 95 of 2026 dated 18.02.2026 under Sections 316(2)/318(2)(4)/336(2)(3)/340(2)/351(2) and 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, against the petitioner herein, pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siliguri.
2. On hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the contents of the written complaint, it appears that the allegations also involves the husband of the de facto complainant and that the de facto complainant was allegedly made to sign some papers on an assurance given by her husband for availing loan and top-up of loan.
3. Considering the nature of allegations, a prima facie case is made out by the petitioner and the materials on record, and as such the revision is required to be heard in presence of the opposite parties.

4. Accordingly, petitioner is directed to serve upon the opposite parties and file affidavit-of-service before the next Circuit Bench.
5. Pending hearing, the proceedings pertaining to Siliguri P.S. Case No. 95 of 2026 dated 18.02.2026 under Sections 316(2)/318(2)(4)/336(2)(3)/340(2)/351(2) and 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, against the petitioner herein, pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siliguri, be stayed in respect of the petitioner herein, till 27th August, 2026 or until further orders whichever is earlier.
6. Matter be listed before the next Circuit Bench.
