By filing the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks grant of notional and consequential service benefits from the date of approval of his appointment. The petitioner is presently serving as an Assistant Teacher in the Social Science (History) Group at Ganesh High School, Kalimpong.

The grievance of the petitioner is that although he was empanelled for appointment as an Assistant Teacher on February 15, 2011, his appointment could be effected only after a series of litigations. His appointment was ultimately approved on December 15, 2012.

At this stage, this Court is not inclined to examine the merits of the petitioner's claim. It appears that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated April 30, 2026, before the Executive Director of Education, Gorkhaland Territorial Administration, Department of Education, respondent no. 5, a copy whereof appears at page 35 of the writ petition.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent no. 5 to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated April 30, 2026, within a period of one month from the date of communication of this order, strictly in accordance with law. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner forthwith.

Accordingly, **WPA 994 of 2026** is disposed of.
