1. The petitioner was an Assistant Teacher and ultimately retired as Headmaster of a High Madrasah. He retired on **November 30, 2025**.



Since then he has not received pension. To receive pension is the legal right of the petitioner.

2. The record shows that a co-ordinate Bench had directed by its order dated **July 8, 2026** the State to file a report within three weeks, till date no such response has come from the State. The issue needs to be expedited forthwith.

3. Accordingly following directions are made:

- (a) Petitioner shall serve a copy of this writ petition along with a copy of today's order upon the respondent nos. 5, 6 and 7;
- (b) Respondent no. 5 upon issuing a prior hearing notice of at least **seven days** to the petitioner, respondent nos. 6 and 7 and after granting them an opportunity of hearing shall decide the issue in the light of the case made out in the writ petition by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law;
- (c) The entire exercise shall be carried out and completed by the respondent no. 5 by passing a reasoned order positively within a period of **six weeks** from the date of communication of this order;
- (d) The reasoned order shall be communicated to the petitioner, respondent no. 4, the respondent nos. 6 and 7 positively within a period of **two weeks** from the date of the said reasoned order to be passed.



- (e) The respondent no. 6 shall forthwith then sanction the Pension Payment Order and shall complete the necessary calculation and after quantify the amount shall send all the records to the respondent no. 4 positively within a period of **three weeks** from the date of receiving the said reasoned order.
- (f) The respondent no. 4 shall then issue necessary Pension Payment Order (PPO) positively within **two weeks** from the date of receiving the calculation from respondent no. 6.
- (g) The respondent no. 4 shall then transmit the PPO to the jurisdictional Treasury Officer who shall take all necessary and consequential steps and start payment of present pension in favour of the petitioner by crediting his bank account through electronic mode. The Treasury Officer shall also pay the arrear **from the next date of retirement** of the petitioner along with interest @ **6% per annum from the next date of retirement** of the petitioner until amount is actually tendered to the petitioner.
- (h) It is needless to mention that, all other allied retiral benefits shall also be paid to the petitioner within the said time frame after being calculated by the appropriate authority.
4. Since affidavits are not called for, and the State has not filed its response as already directed, the allegations made in this writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted by the respondents.



5. With the above observations and directions this writ petition being

WPA 1022 of 2026 stands **disposed of**, without any order as to costs.
