1. This is a anticipatory bail application in connection with Kotwali Police Station Case No. 389 of 2026 dated 08.05.2026 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109/74/351(2)/3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, corresponding to G.R.Case No. 733 of 2026.
2. Having perused the materials on record and CD and having heard learned advocates for the petitioners as well as the State it is found that two groups of persons were involved in free fight resulting into bleeding injuries of members of both the groups.
3. However, considering the injury of the victim as transpired in the injury report in the instant case not to be grievous in nature I am inclined to allow the petitioners' bail prayer.

4. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall furnish a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, CoochBehar. The petitioners shall comply with the condition under Section 482(2) of the 2023 BNSS and shall cooperate with investigation in all possible way. They shall not intimidate witnesses in any manner and shall not tamper with the evidence of the case in any manner whatsoever.
5. C.D be returned.
