1. The instant revisional application has been filed by the petitioners who are the parents-in-law of the private respondent seeking quashing of the proceedings of Kumargram Police Station Case No.167 of 2023 dated August 22, 2023.
2. It is submitted by learned advocate for the petitioners that private respondent lodged written complaint against her husband, the parents-in-law and two sisters-in-law. The police investigated the case and submitted charge-sheet. Two sisters-in-law moved before this Hon'ble Court in CRR 90 of 2026 and by an order passed on June 17, 2026, proceedings in G.R. Case No.1599 of 2023 in connection with Kumargram Police

Station Case No. 167 of 2023 was quashed in respect of the petitioners in CRR 90 of 2026.

3. Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that allegations made against the petitioners in the written complaint, chargesheet and other documents in connection with the aforesaid police case are similar to that against the petitioners in CRR 90 of 2026. On such ground, learned advocate for the petitioners has sought for quashing of the proceedings in respect of the G.R. Case No.1599 of 2023 pending before the Learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court at Alipurduar.
4. Having heard the submissions made on behalf of the learned advocates for the petitioners and also upon perusal of the materials place with the record, it would be appropriate to hear the private respondent on the merits of the proceeding.
5. Petitioners will serve copy of the revisional application upon the opposite parties and file affidavit-of-service to that effect on the next date.
6. List the matter as “Contested Application” on **July 29, 2025.**
7. In the facts and circumstances of the case, let further proceedings in G.R. Case No.1599 of 2023 pending before the Learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, at Alipurduar shall remain stayed till July 31, 2026 or until further orders whichever is earlier.

8. CRAN/1/2026 is disposed of.
