This writ petition has been filed seeking revocation of the suspension order issued by the District Primary School Council, Jalpaiguri, against the petitioner.

The petitioner is an Assistant Teacher at Girangoch B.F. Primary School under the Rajganj III Circle, Jalpaiguri. It appears that the petitioner was arrested on May 28, 2024, in connection with Rajganj Police Station Case No. 289 of 2024, dated August 11, 2024, registered under Sections 115 (2)/74/103 (1)/ 3 (5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

In view of his detention in custody for more than forty-eight hours, the District Primary School Council issued an order of suspension on December 30, 2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged offence bears no nexus with the discharge of his official duties and, therefore, the suspension ought to be revoked.

Having considered the submissions, I am of the view that the petitioner shall submit a representation before the District Primary School Council, Jalpaiguri, seeking withdrawal of the suspension order. There is no reason to keep this writ petition pending.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction upon the District Primary School Council to consider the petitioner's representation dated November 6, 2025, appearing at page 28 of the writ petition, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of communication of this order.

Accordingly, **WPA 1110 of 2026** stands disposed of.
