1. Learned advocate for the petitioner claims parity. The co-accused was granted bail by an order passed on February 11, 2026 in CRM(NDPS) 629 of 2025. It is submitted that the present petitioner was also arrested on the selfsame day.
2. Learned advocate for the State disputes the ground of parity. It is submitted that the order dated February 11, 2026 was obtained by misrepresentation of fact. Learned advocate for the State relies upon writing dated February 15, 2025 by which grounds of arrest were communicated to the petitioner. He also submits that the State proposes to file an application for cancellation of bail granted by

order dated February 11, 2026 by Monday i.e, August 3, 2026.

3. At this stage, learned advocate for the petitioner prays that the matter be adjourned until the prayer for cancellation of bail is decided.
