1. The petitioner says that the grounds of arrest were never communicated to her before she being arrested. She further says that two co-accused persons have been granted bail on the above ground by a Coordinate Bench by an order dated February 11, 2026.

2. Learned State Advocate says that the order dated February 11, 2026 was obtained by suppressing material fact. Grounds of arrest were very much communicated to all the accused persons.

3. The case diary is placed before me. It appears from the memo of arrest that the grounds of arrest were communicated to the accused persons.

4. Therefore, I am not inclined to allow this application since commercial quantity of narcotics was recovered from the accused persons including this petitioner.

5. CRM (NDPS) 395 of 2026 is, thus, dismissed.
