The petitioner seeks quashing of NJP P.S. case no.411 of 2025 dated 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2025.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

A complaint was lodged by the de facto complainant/2<sup>nd</sup> opposite party herein against the petitioner alleging offence under Section 69 of the BNS.

The petitioner was in a long-standing consensual relationship with the de facto complainant which turned sour subsequently.

In connection with the said complaint, the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court by an order passed on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 in CRM (A) 395 of 2025. On the next date, that is, on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2025, the present complaint has been lodged on several allegations. The allegations made out in the present complaint have not found place in the earlier complaint though the alleged

incident stated in the present complaint dates back to the period prior to lodging of the earlier complaint.

Upon consideration of the material on record, this Court is of the view that the petitioner has been able to make out an arguable case.

The petitioner is directed to serve copy of the application along with annexure thereto upon the opposite parties and file affidavit of service on the adjourned date.

The matter be placed before the next available Circuit Bench.

Investigation of the case shall continue.

No coercive steps be taken against the petitioner in connection with the present matter till 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2025 or until further orders, whichever is earlier subject to the petitioner co operating in investigation.

Since the petitioner is an army official posted at Pune he may co operate in investigation through virtual platform unless his physical presence is absolutely required by the investigating officer for the purpose of investigation.

Urgent certified website copy of the order, if applied for, be given to the parties on compliance of requisite formalities.
