This instant revisional application has been filed challenging the order dated 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2024 passed in connection with Ptn/R/.No.364/2024 passed by the learned Executive Magistrate at Jalpaiguri, wherein Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Jalpaiguri passed an order issuing search warrant for seizure of Stridhan property exercising jurisdiction under Section 94 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Learned advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that specific case has already been started under Sections 498(A)/ 307/ 34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act with reference to Jalpaigri Women Police Station Case No.35/2024 dated 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 pending before the learned C.J.M., Jalpaiguri.

Petitioner is directed to serve notice upon the opposite party no.2 through Speed Post with A/D and also upon the State through the office of learned Additional Public Prosecutor of this Court intimating the date of hearing and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.

Learned advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner has also

prayed for stay of operation of the order impugned.

In the given facts and circumstances, the operation of the order dated 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2024 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Jalpaiguri in Ptn/R/.No.364/2024 under Section 94 of the Code of Criminal Procedure be stayed for a period of eight weeks from date or until further order, whichever is earlier.

Let the matter appear before the next available Circuit Bench.
