1. This revisional application has been filed with a prayer for quashing of the proceeding in connection with CR. No. 46 of 2019 pending before the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act was filed against three accused including the petitioner.
3. It has been further submitted that cheque was drawn by accused No. 1. and accused No. 3 is in-charge of day to day affairs of the company i.e accused no.1. Therefore, petitioner being accused No.2 has no role to play in this case.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner No. 2 is not the director of the company/accused No.1.
5. Having heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf

of the petitioner as well as having gone through the documents annexed herewith, the same stands admitted.

6. Petitioner is directed to serve the opposite parties through speed post with A/D and to file affidavit of service on the returnable date.
7. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has also prayed for stay of the proceeding involved in this revisional application, otherwise the very purpose of filing of this revisional application shall stand frustrated.
8. Regard being had to the above, let the proceeding in connection with CR. No. 46 of 2019 pending before the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri be stayed for a limited period i.e one week after puja vacation, 2025 or until further order whichever is earlier.
9. Let the matter appear before the next available Circuit in the month of September, 2025.
