1. This is an application under Section 482 read with Section 401 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 read with Section 442/528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
2. The present petitioners are implicated in connection with Dinhata Police Station Case No.497 of 2026 dated 08.07.2026 under Section 384/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
3. It is submitted by the Learned Counsel for the Petitioners that allegations are omnibus in nature

dating back to the year 2010 ending to the year 2025. Such vague allegations demand quashing as no specific incident of alleged offences are mentioned in the written complaint. It is further submitted that in a similar matter, Co-ordinate Bench allowed the interim relief to the Petitioners therein. Accordingly, it is prayed that notice may be issued and interim protection may be given.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor produced Case Diary and opposing the bail application, invited the attention of the Court to the statement of the witnesses recorded under Sections 161 and 164, which are incriminating in nature.
5. I have heard the rival submissions and perused the Case Diary.
6. Investigation is at early stage. At this stage, quashing of the allegation against the present petitioners, is unwarranted. In case, proper materials are not available against the present Petitioners, the same can be agitated at the time of consideration of charge. As of now, it is not a fit case where extra-ordinary

jurisdiction shall be exercised quashing investigation against the present Petitioners.

7. Accordingly, the instant application stands dismissed. Liberty is given to apply for bail before the Trial Court and the Trial Court will consider the same without being influenced by this Order.
