1. This is an application praying for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023.
2. The present Petitioners are indicted in connection with Jalpaiguri Women Police Station Case No.101 of 2026 dated 04.08.2026 under Sections 108/3(5)/85 of BNS, 2023.
3. Mr. Saha Podder, the Learned Counsel for the petitioners submitted that these persons are near relatives of the deceased. The husband is in custody. Therefore, Mr.Saha Podder prayed for bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor objected to the bail application on the ground that incriminating materials are available in Case Diary and allegations are serious in nature.
5. I have perused Case Diary and heard rival submission.
6. It is in the statement of witnesses that these three persons were relative of the deceased and they were living separately. Nothing is there to indicate that they actively participated in the offence.
7. Considering the rival submissions and on perusal of Case Diary, I am inclined to allow anticipatory bail to the present Petitioners on furnishing sureties of Rs.15,000/- each, one being local with further direction that they will meet Investigating Officer once in a week till the investigation is pending, shall not tamper evidence or influence any witnesses.
