The opposite party no. 2 lodged Falakata P.S. Case No. 219 of 2023 dated 18.5.2023, under Sections 376/417/323/379/427/506/34 of the IPC, against the present petitioners.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners has submitted that the dispute arose due to misunderstanding in the love affair and relationship between petitioner no. 1 and opposite party no. 2. It is stated that during the pendency of the criminal case, as above, the parties were married.

Since the police submitted FRT in the case, however, the opposite party no. 2 has submitted her "Naraji" petition before the trial Court as regards the FRT submitted by police in this case.

The petitioners are of the opinion that the entire proceedings as above is frivolous against him and seeks setting aside of the order of the Court dated August 6, 2024, by dint of which the Court has directed for reinvestigation in the matter.

Let a notice be served upon the opposite parties including the defacto complaint.

Let there be a stay of all further proceedings in connection with G.R. Case No. 930 of 2023 arising out of Falakata P.S. Case No. 219 of 2023 dated 18.5.2023 upto the next date when the Court shall take up this matter for hearing.

Let this matter be placed before the next Circuit Bench.
