The private opposite party is present in Court and submits that she no longer intends to settle the matter mutually with the petitioners. She submits that pursuant to the affidavit sworn by the parties, she went to her matrimonial home but was ill treated and tortured by the petitioners therein.

The revisional application be placed before the next available Circuit Bench.
