1. This is an application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The present petitioners
are implicated under Sections 85/117(2)/109 of BNS, 2023
read with Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 in
connection with NJP P.S. Case No. 494/2026 dated
17.08.2026.
2. The present petitioners are husband, mother-in-law and
father-in-law. Injury report does not show any internal

injury. Statements of witnesses carry omnibus and sweeping allegations.

3. Considering and perusing the C.D. and other materials, I am inclined to allow anticipatory bail on furnishing two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be a local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri with a further condition that the male petitioners will meet the I.O. once in a week till the investigation is complete; shall not tamper evidence or influence the witnesses and shall cooperate the investigation.
4. This application accordingly stands disposed of.
5. C.D. be returned.
