1. The instant application is filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 praying for bail.
2. The petitioner has been indicted under Section 46 (A)(c) of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 in connection with Matigara P.S. Case No. 471 of 2026 dated 19.07.2026.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 19th July, 2026 and maximum punishment is three years.
4. Heard Learned Counsels and perused C.D.

5. Let the petitioner be allowed bail on furnishing two sureties of Rs.20,000/- each, one of whom must be a local, to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Siliguri with a further condition that the petitioner will meet I.O. once in a week till the investigation is complete; shall not tamper evidence or influence the witnesses and shall cooperate the investigation.
6. CRM (R)/40/2026 stands disposed of accordingly.
