Drawing our attention to the averments in paragraph 4 of the application for condonation of delay, Mr. Kundu, learned advocate appearing for the appellant submits that the delay which has occurred, is neither deliberate nor *mala fide*. The appellant was under extreme financial crisis and he had to approach the Legal Services Committee, High Court for preferring the present appeal.

Mr. Chakraborty, learned Additional Public Prosecutor enters appearance on behalf of the State.
