Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner sought statutory bail on the 185<sup>th</sup> day of his custody. After his application for bail was adjourned, charge sheet was submitted by the Investigating officer. In view of the same, the petitioner is entitled to statutory bail.

Learned counsel for the State takes this Court to an order passed by the learned Special Judge on 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 wherein it is recorded that charge sheet was submitted on the 176<sup>th</sup> day preceding submission of bail application by the accused-petitioner.

In reply, learned counsel for the State submits that since cognizance of the charge sheet not taken by the learned Special Judge before the bail application was filed, the petitioner had exercised his indefeasible right of bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks accommodation to produce authorities in this regard.
