The Court: This is an application for issuance of fresh Writ of Summons in the backdrop as stated hereinafter.

Before the Writ of Summons could be lodged with the original reliefs claimed in the suit, the plaint has undergone an amendment, as a consequence whereof the reliefs have changed resulting in the change in the concise statement required to be provided in the Writ of Summons. The plaintiff, therefore, seeks issuance of fresh Writ of Summons with the amended reliefs and the fresh concise statement.

Let such fresh Writ of Summons be issued within a period of three weeks from date. The plaintiff shall be liable to lodge the same in time for the

amended plaint along with the fresh Writ of Summons for being served on the defendants complying with the applicable rules.

The defendant nos.4, 5 and 6 are represented by Mr. Dhiraj Trivedi, learned Senior Advocate being instructed by Mr. Bikash Kumar Singh, learned Advocate. It is submitted on behalf of the said defendants that the service of the Writ of Summons on the said defendants no. 4, 5 and 6 may be dispensed with provided his clients are given sufficient time to file the written statement.

The submission on behalf of the defendant nos.4, 5 and 6 being fair and reasonable, the plaintiff is directed to serve a copy of the amended plaint with legible annexure thereto within 7 days from date to the learned advocate for the defendant nos. 4, 5 and 6. The defendant nos.4, 5 and 6 shall be entitled to file their written statement within eight weeks from date by dispensing with the service of the fresh Writ of Summons.

Nothing further remains to be adjudicated in this application.

The application being GA 3 of 2025 is, accordingly, disposed of.
